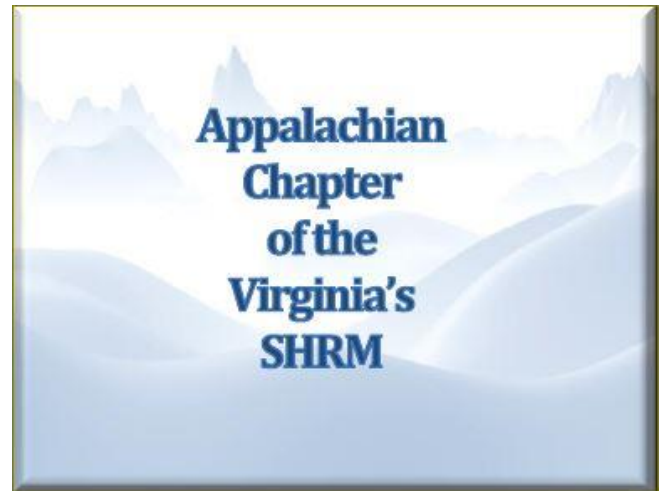
WHAT IS SHRM?
